

Elliott Kim, 14, is a freshman at Archbishop Mitty High School in San Jose. He started playing piano at age six and cello at seven under the tutelage of Kyeong Hwa Kim.

Elliott has won multiple awards from several competitions including 1st place in 2020 & 2017 KAMSA Competition, 2019 United States International Music Competition. He earned 2nd place in 2018 Pacific Musical Society Competition and 2017 US Open Music Competition, and 3rd place in 2016 Korea Times Youth Music Competition. He was also selected as an outstanding performer in the 2019 Junior Bach Festival for its final concert.

In addition, he has participated in California Philharmonic Youth Orchestra since 2016, and won the Concerto Competition of CPYO twice in 2017 and 2019. He is also an avid chamber musician. His chamber group, Bravi quartet at Young Chamber Musician, recently received 1st place in 2020 International Grand Music Competition.
