## Third Place, Patron of the Arts Award (\$600)

**Yuli Choi,** age 15, violin, won first place in the Korean Times Competition in 2014 and 2015. During the 2015-2016 season, she joined the Palo Alto Chamber Orchestra. In 2017 she won 4<sup>th</sup> place in the U. S. Open Competition, and in 2019 she won 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
