

2018-2019 Young Musicians Competition Piano and String Instruments

Competition Date: Sunday, April 28, 2019 at Burlingame Woman's Club, 241 Park Road, Burlingame, CA.

Founded in 1930, a major purpose of the non-profit Burlingame Music Club (BMC) is to provide performance opportunities for gifted young musicians. Generous cash awards are given for competition winners. BMC is proud to be a member of the California and the National Federation of Music Clubs (NFMC). Both offer student competitions for cash awards. Information on eligibility and applications are available upon request at nfmc-music.org.

BMC Eligibility Rules:

Age: Applicants must be at least 12 years of age and not more than 18 years of age by April 28, 2019.

<u>Performances:</u> A student entering our competition must commit to three (3) performance dates as follows:

Perform a ten (10) minute program at one of our BMC meetings. Meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of each month from November through April from 1 − 3 PM. Students are encouraged to present selections different from their required competition repertoire. Students must make arrangements with their school to be excused to attend their performance date. Performance dates are listed below and will be assigned when all applications have been received. There may be some evening performance dates available.

Nov. 12th, Dec. 10th, Jan. 14th, Feb. 11th, Mar. 11th, and Apr. 8th.

A performance for the Burlingame Music Club is a requirement to enter the competition. If needed, students are required to provide their own accompanists for the club and competition performances.

- 2. <u>Perform</u> at a judged competition on Sunday, April 28, 2019. Times will be assigned between 12:30 and 5:00 PM. See required repertoire below. Repertoire for competition must be memorized. Each student is allowed 15 minutes for performance.
- 3. <u>Perform</u>: Winners <u>MUST PERFORM</u> at our meeting on Monday, May 13, 2019 in order to collect their cash prize.

Required Repertoire: Student performers must select standard repertoire of recognized excellence by composers from (3) of the following periods of music – Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impressionistic, and Contemporary. An American composer may be included if so desired.

Note: There is a limitation on the number of entries. October 1, 2018 is the cut-off date for applications.
